## **“Policy instruments to promote sustainable consumption”**

**Brussels Thursday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2008 (10.00 am to 4.30 pm)**

The project “Assessing the potential of various instruments for sustainable consumption practices and greening of the market” (ASCEE) which is funded within the EU’s 6<sup>th</sup> Framework Programme deals with innovative policy instruments supporting the transition to Sustainable Consumption and Production (SCP). The research conducted within ASCEE, such as a Europe-wide inquiry into national policy instruments and case studies into selected approaches, revealed the need for knowledge transfer and information exchange between policy makers from different European countries.

Therefore, the ASCEE expert workshop will provide the opportunity for a **poster exhibition**. Representatives from public administrations, from Civil Society Organisations, from academia, and also from business are invited to present a poster introducing a **good practice** for the promotion of sustainable consumption patterns.

### **Posters**

- may refer to different types of policy instruments, such as regulation (e.g., product standards), economic instruments (e.g., taxes, public procurement), information instruments (e.g. labelling, communication campaigns), cooperative approaches, etc.
- may address issues such as drivers for the introduction of the instrument, impacts, success factors, experiences, evaluations and assessments etc.,
- should be one page (DIN A0).

The poster presentations may be supplemented by additional information material offered to workshop participants.

Since space for poster presentations is limited, the organisers reserve the right to select the most appealing presentations in the case of numerous submissions.

Any interested party should submit an abstract on the poster presentation along with the registration to the workshop.

### **Abstract submission details:**

- abstracts will be evaluated by the ASCEE project team
